**Eight “2010 Macau Galaxy Entertainment FIVB World Grand Prix”  
star players will be elected to compete for the  
“My Favorite Galaxy Star Player” Award**

**Macau, Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China (Thursday, July 8, 2010)** – Galaxy Entertainment Group (“GEG” or “Galaxy Entertainment”) announced today that it will title sponsor the “2010 Macau Galaxy Entertainment FIVB World Grand Prix” for the sixth consecutive year. Sanctioned by the Federation Internationale de Volleyball and organized by the Macau Sport Development Board and the Volleyball Association of Macao, China, the competition will take place between August 13 and 15 at the Macau Forum. In addition, GEG and the organizing committee sincerely thanked both the Macau and Hong Kong Sports Press Associations for expertly shortlisting the players. GEG hopes that this year's election can continue to receive the support from volleyball fans.

Second Stage	
On-site Spectators Voting (August 13 to 15)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Eight voting boxes will be set up and placed inside GEG’s exhibition booth for spectators to cast their votes. Spectators are advised to cast their vote as soon as they arrive at the venue because all voting boxes will be removed (and all voting terminated) one hour after the commencement of the second match on each day.</li> <li>● Each spectator will receive only one voting slip upon entering the venue and is therefore, entitled to cast only one vote. Any spectator found to submit more than one voting slip, his/her subsequent voting slips will automatically be withdrawn and considered invalid</li> <li>● The accumulated number of votes received by each nominee will be announced at the end of the second match on each day.</li> <li>● The nominee to accumulate the most votes at the end of 3-day competition will be named this year’s “My Favorite Galaxy Star Player”</li> <li>● One lucky spectator who casted his/her vote for this year’s “My Favorite Galaxy Star Player” Award recipient will be drawn from the award recipient’s voting box at the end of the 3-day competition</li> </ul>
