



“Galaxy Stars” Men’s Dragon Boat Team participated in the “Macau 2010 7th Club Crew World Championships”

In June, Galaxy Entertainment Group (“GEG”)’s “Galaxy Stars” men’s dragon boat team finished third in the local 500m standard dragon boat race at the “2010 Macau International Dragon Boat Races”. In addition to receiving an award, “Galaxy Stars” also received a special invitation from the Macau Sport Development Board and the Macau, China Dragon Boat Association to participate in the “7th Club Crew World Championships”.

Held every two years, the “Club Crew World Championships” are sanctioned by the International Dragon Boat Federation. “Standard Boat Premier Open – 200M Plate Finals” and second runner-up at the “Standard Boat Premier Open – 500M Plate Finals”, placing it in the 13th and 15th spot respectively, at the “7th Club Crew World Championships”.
