

<u>GEG Supports the Macau Grand Prix and Organizes Various</u> <u>Activities to Engage the Community</u>

November 15, 2023 – Galaxy Entertainment Group ("GEG") facilitates Macau's sports development by proactively supporting, joining, and organizing various sports events and activities. Leveraging on the series of Macau Grand Prix celebration events that were being held at Galaxy Macau, GEG organized an exclusive session at the Pit Stop Challenge for approximately 40 people from the Macau Autism Association, Sheng Kung Hui Macau Social Services Coordination Office ("SKH"), the GEG Youth Achievement Program ("YAP"), and the Macao New Chinese Youth Association. The session provided participants with an opportunity to gain insights into a Formula One champion team and take part in a range of exciting racing-themed games, such as using real pit crew tools to change tires, challenging the professional reaction tester, and experiencing the excitement of the Guia Circuit through a racing simulator, which they all enjoyed with enthusiasm. Furthermore, GEG also invited over 70 members and youth from the Lui Che Woo College of University of Macau, SKH, the Macau Special Olympics, and the YAP to watch the thrilling races on the first day of the Macau Grand Prix races.

GEG is committed to supporting the Macau SAR Government's directions to develop local sports and promoting the integrated development of sports and tourism.
