

Chinese Gold Medalists Celebrate Christmas at Galaxy with Santa Ron and Caritas Students

Also present were residents and tourists who had gathered to take photos and catch a glimpse of the gold medalists.

During Christmas, GEG invites the famous Santa Ron to deliver festive blessings to guests at Galaxy Macau each year. Santa Ron has been very active in the film and television industry in the past 50 years and has starred in Hollywood movies, TV shows, giant brand advertisements and holiday parades. This time, GEG invited Santa Ron to celebrate Christmas at Santa's Grotto at Galaxy Macau, where he entertained the students from Escola Caritas de Macau and the gold medalists with his Christmas stories.
